

- Shared Access Conveniently located for easy use by residents.




## **Packing & Moving Process**



## **Packing and Moving Support**

- Free moving assistance provided by Move Solutions
- Packing kits available for pick-up beginning November 17 in the Chisholm Hall Activity Center
- Packing instructions emailed with your room assignment on November 13-14
- Reminder: Move remains free if residents pack according to instructions; unprepared rooms may incur charges





#### **Self-Moves**

#### **SELF MOVE WINDOW – DEC. 11-12**

- Packing Kits: Available for pickup in the Chisholm Hall Activity Center starting Nov. 17
- Moving Carts: Limited moving bins will be available for checkout at the front desk
- **Drop Off:** This is only for moving items that you would prefer for the moving company to not move. Blanco Hall will not officially open until December 15.

#### **ESSENTIALS ONLY**

- Keep what you need for classes, finals and daily use
- Clean your room so final checkout is easy!

#### **PICK UP YOUR KIT**

- Grab your packing kit starting Nov. 17
- Get ready to pack as soon as you return from break



## **Packing Kits**

#### **Packing Kit Contents:**

- 10 Boxes
- Bubble wrap
- Packing tape
- Marker

- Colored labels
- Packing instructions
- Move-out checklist

#### **Additional Instructions:**

- All items must be packed and labeled by Dec.
   12
- Make sure to empty, defrost, and dry minifridges
- Bathroom items aren't needed at Blanco! (shower curtains, bathmats, toilet paper)
- Clean your room and remove all trash
