Move In

UTSA Move-In Days are August 20th –23rd. Over the course of these four days, we will welcome over 3,000 new and returning Roadrunners into their on-campus homes. To ensure that the move-in experience goes smoothly for everyone, we have a structured move-in process that allows us to manage the flow of cars and people on campus and in the residence halls.

Your move-in date is based on the residence hall you are moving into. Unless approved specifically by UTSA Housing, your move-in date is set and cannot be changed. On Friday, July 19, you will receive an email from us to sign up for your arrival timeslot on your move-in date. Meal Plans

Meal plans make it easy to dine on campus! Enjoy fresh, chef-inspired meals at the all-you-care-to-eat Roadrunner Cafe, or visit a variety of popular retail locations, including Chick-fil-A, Starbucks, Freebirds, and more. As a reminder, students residing in Laurel Village, Chaparral Village, Alvarez Hall, Guadalupe Hall or Chisholm Hall with 48 or fewer completed semester credit hours are required to purchase a meal plan.

UTSA Dining provides a selection of meal plans designed to fit your dining needs and campus lifestyle. Visit <u>Campus Dish</u> to review meal plan options and find the one that fits your needs, then sign up through your <u>myUTSA</u> account.

Parking Permits

If you plan to bring a vehicle to campus, you'll need a parking permit. Resident parking is available in numerous lots around the residence halls using a Resident "H" permit. Parking lots are not reserved for any particular residence hall—with the "H" permit, you can park in any available residential space or commuter space.

Purchase your permit online through <u>MyParking</u>. Buy now and pay later by adding the permit cost to your tuition and fees during checkout. Permits begin shipping on August 1 and take 5-7 days to arrive. Please note that permits cannot be mailed to residence halls. Send them to your permanent address or an on-campus mailbox, available at the <u>UPS Store</u> on campus to rent.

UTSACard

The UTSACard is your official university ID, providing access to meal plans, residence halls, the rec center, athletic events, and more. If you visit campus during orientation, be sure to visit Campus Services to pick up your card.
